Chile	Chardonnay Reserve, Santa Ema, 2008	£26.90
	Bright golden yellow. Intense and complex with delicate notes of toasty oak balanced with honey and ripe tropical fruits. Crisp and refreshing with good balance and a long and pleasing finish.	
Chile	Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve, Santa Ema, 2006	£26.90
	Rich, fulsome, plummy fruit & spice aromas lead to a juicy wine of rich tannins, great length and delicious concentrated flavour.

France	Montagny 1er Cru, Olivier Lafaive, Burgundy, 2007	£36.00
	From Premier Cru vineyards, of relatively high marl content in the soil. This wine has a slightly more citric grapefruit quality. Weighty but with mineral touches and gently infused vanilla oak.	
Italy	Fiano Di Avellino, Terre di Dora DOC, 2007	£36.90
	Subtle notes of mature fruit and flowers with hints of pear, apricot, citrus fruits, toasted hazelnuts, acacia, hawthorn and honey. From the Campania region it is persistent and aromatic.	
South Africa	Chardonnay, Meerlust Estate, Stellenbosch, 2007	£41.90
	Lime, crushed lemongrass & cream on the nose. Fresh on the palate with citrusy and tropical fruit flavours followed by a rich creaminess & concentrated fruit finish.

Australia	Shiraz, Bloodstone, Gemtree Vineyards, McLaren Vale 2006 Open fermented for 10 days then gently pressed into French and American oak for twelve months, McLaren Vale has a cooler more maritime climate than other Australian regions, hence the more restrained peppery style of Shiraz here	£31.90
Italy	Amarone Della Valpolicella Classico, Tedeschi, 2005 From 30 year-old wines, the grapes are harvested in early October then left to dry on racks until January which concentrates the sugars and flavour. The wine is full and rich with amazing fruit intensity and a velvety palate.	£65.00
South Africa	Pinot Noir, Meerlust Estate, Stellenbosch, 2004 The only Pinot Noir to receive the coveted five star rating in the 2009 Platter guide. Exuberant floral nose with hints of violets, cherries and baking spice. Juicy red fruit flavours and silky, supple tannins.	£43.00
