	Due to the cooler ripening conditions this years wine has a very pronounced variety of flavours such as pineapple, granadilla, melon and green apple giving great structure with lovely balancing acidity	
South Africa	Ruby Cabernet, the Veldt Range 2009	£22.90
	Ruby Cabernet is a result of crossing Cabernet Sauvignon with Carignan vines, which gives the resulting wine an injection of dark, inky fruit character whilst also lightening the classic structure and tannin of Cabernet Sauvignon

	This is aged on its lees with no oak aging at all. As a result it's superbly juicy, with a leasy nose, lots of ripe melon, grapefruit, pineapple and a super complexity. The finish is creamy and floral and very moreish	
Italy	Fiano Di Avellino, Terre di Dora DOC, 2008	£36.90
	Subtle notes of mature fruit and flowers with hints of pear, apricot, citrus fruits, toasted hazelnuts, acacia, hawthorn and honey. From the Campania region it is persistent and aromatic.	
South Africa	Chardonnay, Meerlust Estate, Stellenbosch, 2008	£41.90
	Lime, crushed lemongrass & cream on the nose. Fresh on the palate with citrusy and tropical fruit flavours followed by a rich creaminess & concentrated fruit finish.

Australia	Shiraz/Viognier, Bloodstone, Gemtree Vineyards, McLaren Vale 2008 Open fermented for 10 days then gently pressed into French and American oak for twelve months, McLaren Vale has a cooler more maritime climate than other Australian regions, hence the more restrained peppery style of Shiraz here	£31.90
Italy	Amarone Della Valpolicella Classico, Adalia, 2005 From 30 year-old wines, the grapes are harvested in early October then left to dry on racks until January which concentrates the sugars and flavour. The wine is full and rich with amazing fruit intensity and a velvety palate.	£65.00
South Africa	Pinot Noir, Meerlust Estate, Stellenbosch, 2006 The only Pinot Noir to receive the coveted five star rating in the 2009 Platter guide. Exuberant floral nose with hints of violets, cherries and baking spice. Juicy red fruit flavours and silky, supple tannins.	£44.00
