Taking over his grandfather's vineyards in 2008, Alvar de Dios is one of the young winemakers at the forefront of a revolution of Toro winemaking. Helping shift the focus to single-vineyards, he has championed the untouched old-vine plantings in the region, showing their potential to create truly characterful wines. The Doña Blanca is made from a hundred year old vineyard, carefully restored by Alvar himself. Opening with bright, fresh florals and white peach, the wine feels precise and clean. As the palate develops, there are gentle notes of orchard fruit and a soft spice, always refreshed by the initial minerality. Effortlessly elegant!

Chianti Classico Riserva 'Berardenga', Felsina, Tuscany, 2020, Italy

The Felsina estate lies just outside the city of Siena in the southernmost pocket of the Chianti Classico appellation. Closer in style to their Brunello di Montalcino cousins than the rest of Chianti, Felsina wines epitomise the powerful profile classic to this region. The grapes for the Riserva are hand picked, carefully selected to maintain the quality of fruit, and aged in Slavonian and French oak. The resulting wine is full bodied with a vivid bouquet of blossom, succulent black cherry and blueberry, cloves and a hint of cocoa. With classic Sangiovese fragrance on the nose and a luxurious palate which has softened with time, the Berardenga is a wonderful expression of Tuscany.

Albarino, Pazo Senorans, Rias Baixas, 2023, Spain This is a fine mineral-driven Albarino from the leading Albarino producer in Rias Baixas. Aromas of nectarine, fresh figs, orange zest and white flowers. Dry with citrus flavours and a mineral finish. Perfect with shellfish.	53.95

<p>Bourgogne Chardonnay, Jean-Claude Boisset, 2022, France Classic Burgundian Chardonnay made with a harmony of freshness and fruit expression from highly concentrated, low yielding vines. Bright citrus fruit, white flowers and a tight mineral palate is softened by gentle toasty oak notes.</p>	55.95
<p>Calvarino, Soave Classico, Pieropan, 2022, Italy Arguably the first single vineyard white to be made in Italy, this is a wine whose reputation precedes it. Clean and refreshing, the crystalline lemon and delicate elderflower merge on a pure, minerally driven palate. Mouthwatering and complex: classic Soave, done to perfection.</p>	59.95
<p>Carjanti Bianco, Gulfi, Sicilia, 2019, Italy On Sicily's southeast coast, there are few people crafting wines as good as Gulfi. Working with indigenous and international grape varieties, this is a wine made from 100% organic Carricante grapes, 50% fermented in stainless steel and 50% in large used botti. Fresh and vibrant, boasting orchard fruit flavours such as peach and apple. The fruit follows through to a smooth and delicious palate.</p>	67.95
<p>Fiano, Pietracupa, Campania, 2021, Italy Nowhere is the expression of Fiano more accomplished than around the town of Avellino in Campania, and few produce a more expressive, mineral and balanced example than Pietracupa. On the nose there is a beautiful combination of clear floral notes, jasmine and orange blossom, with ripe green apple and apricots all alongside and a steeliness is calling you to taste. The palate is concentrated and textured, with weaving flavours of sage, honeyed lemon, peach skin and steel, with Pietracupa's hallmark soaring acidity that lingers for what feels like hours.</p>	69.95
<p>Chablis Premier Cru, Cote Lechet, Les Hauts De Milly, 2022, France The Kimmeridgian clay soils in Côte de Léchet lend this wine a distinct saline edge and powerful character. The nose is fragrant with aromas of white flowers, lemon and apricot and hints of gunflint. On the palate are intense citrus fruit flavours and a persistent salinity which carry through to the long finish.</p>	69.95
<p>'Reid Ulm' Nussberg Wiener Gemischter Satz, Weininger, 2021, Austria From a single vineyard overlooking Vienna, a traditional field blend of nine grape varieties, 'Reid Ulm' is absolutely unique and a joy to drink. With shoots of gold in the glass, it has elegant aromatics of ripe white and yellow fruit - balancing a full bodied softness with a limestone mineral precision that refreshes each sip. Lush and concentrated with a lingering salinity.</p>	69.95
<p>Bourgogne Blanc, Clos du Chateau, Domaine de Montille, 2021, France Sourced entirely from a single, organically farmed vineyard located within the walls of the actual Chateau Puligny-Montrachet itself which was classed as the garden when the original classification for the region took place, this vineyard is now home to 50 year old vines which exemplify the elegance attainable from truly well crafted Burgundy Chardonnay. Delicate white blossom and peaches on the nose give way to a strongly textured palate with a flinty, mineral edge.</p>	99.95
<p>Chardonnay, Whitewolfe, North Downs, 2022, England The maiden release from Clare Whitehead and Luke Wolfe at Kit's Coty in the North Downs of England has received huge critical acclaim. This shows clearly that the days of English terroir only producing sparkling wines are long gone. Vibrant and fresh with a classic mineral edge, intrinsic to good English wine, the wine evolves in the glass revealing masterfully integrated oak which lends the palate weight and presence.</p>	89.95
<p>Roussanne, Chateau Le Devay, Northern Rhone, 2022, France Le Devay shows the generosity and tension possible from the great terroirs of the Northern Rhone Valley. Carefully harvested by hand and fermented slowly at low temperatures to preserve the aromatics of the grape, this is beautifully textured and brimming with vibrant citrus notes of lemon peel and grapefruit.</p>	89.95

- Altopiano, Terre Di Chieti Rosso, Abruzzo, IGT 2022, Italy** 28.95
100% montepulciano. Ruby red with red berry fruits, wild cherries & violet with a delicate spice & soft tannins.
- Carignan, Vieilles Vignes, Mont Rocher, 2021, France** 29.95
100% carignan from old vines producing a well-structured wine with dark berry fruit & spice on the palate with a zingy & uplifting finish.
- Merlot, Montes, Colchagua Valley, 2022, Chile** 29.95
Vibrant ruby red in colour, this plummy Merlot has hints of vanilla and chocolate with velvety tannins, crisp acidity and a fragrant finish.
- Mencia, Merayo, DO Bierzo, 2022, Spain** 32.95
Made from over 80 year old Mencia bush vines. There is no oak treatment to preserve the aromatic fresh red fruit quality of this variety. Fresh and herbal with a hint of spice on the finish.
- Cotes du Rhone Villages, Famille Perrin, 2021, France** 37.95
A blend of Grenache (70%) and Syrah (30%), this Côtes-du-Rhône Villages is made using the same viticultural and vinification techniques as those employed at Château de Beaucastel.
- The Blend, Gabrielskloof, Walker Bay, 2020, South Africa** 39.95
49% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Cabernet Franc, 14% Petit Verdot, 7% Malbec This blend has aromas of delicate violets and black fruit, with hints of vanilla and tobacco leaf from the time in barrel. Fine velvety tannins and restrained power, balanced with bright acidity and a juicy palate.
- Shiraz, The Cunning Plan, Thistledown, McLaren Vale, 2022, Australia** 42.95
Fruit comes from the Moray Park vineyard in the McLaren Flat sub-region. Low yielding and ultra-intense, Great depth of ripe plum and blackberry fruit flavours. A full bodied wine with a succulent palate, lively spices and fine velvety tannins.
- Malbec Blend, Disobedience, Kaiken, Mendoza, 2020, Argentina** 49.95
'Disobedience' by Francis Mallmann represents the long collaboration between the Argentinian chef and Kaiken. Known for his distinct style of open fire cooking this is a blend of Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot sourced from Altamira and Vistalba. A rounded, rich wine with expressive sweet and spiced red fruit.
- Pinot Noir, Iona, Elgin Highlands, 2021, South Africa** 56.95
A classic, aromatic Pinot Noir from some of the coolest vineyards in South Africa. Delicate rose petal florals, wild strawberry and raspberry lead the palate, underpinned with soft earthy notes. Freshly perfumed with beautiful structure.
- Rioja Reserva, Bodegas Luis Canas 2017, Spain** 53.95
A delicious Reserva from one of the top Rioja Bodegas. It has a dark berry fruit nose and an elegant, flavourful blackberry and raspberry palate together with complex layers of oak, cocoa and balsam hints. Structure, elegance and length.
- Barbera D'Alba, DOC, G.D.Vajra, Piedmonte, 2023, Italy** 54.95
Scented, balanced and lively, Vajra's Barbera d'Alba combines wild forest fruit aromatics with ripe, thirst-quenching raspberry and blackberry with a hint of fig. A wine made with great character and intensity from one of our most favourite and also highly respected producers.
- Cabernet Sauvignon, Nocturne, Margaret River, 2021, Australia** 55.95
For a great value, contemporary Margaret River Cabernet blend that over-delivers then look no further than this release from Julian Langworthy. The 'King of the North' blends Yallingup Cabernet Sauvignon with 30% Merlot for a juicy, blue-fruited beauty with all the great spicy, mineral-dredged goodness that this unique region has to offer.

Cabernet Franc Family, Raats, Stellenbosch, 2020, South Africa 69.95

Made by legendary winemaker Bruwer Raats, this stunning single vineyard Cabernet Franc is a beautiful expression of the Stellenbosch hills. After painstaking care in the winery and 18 months in French oak, the wine shows opulent, perfumed layers of dark cherry, boysenberry and dried violet petal notes. Silky smooth and harmonious!

Ribera del Duero, Finca Villacreces, 2019, Spain 67.95

Made from a meticulous selection of the best vines from the estate's 15 vineyard plots. A perfect blend of 86% Tempranillo, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon and 4% Merlot. Inky purple, with an expressive bouquet of mocha/expresso, toasted bread, graphite, wild blueberries and blackberry liqueur. Full-bodied and plush on the palate, with layers of spicy black fruits and a smoky finish.

Passorosso, Passopisciaro, Etna Rosso DOC, 2021, Italy 69.95

This is a pioneering project from acclaimed winemaker Andrea Franchetti, the sequel to that of his iconic Super Tuscan estate, Tenuta di Trinoro. Made from Nerello Mascalese bush-vines planted between seventy and one hundred years ago on the wild volcanic ash soils of Mt. Etna. Aged in large, neutral oak barrels and unfiltered, the nuance and purity of the grapes is protected giving bright, red-fruit, mineral, and herbaceous aroma's.

Langhe Rosso, Roagna, Piedmont, 2018, Italy 99.95

A stunning Nebbiolo sourced from three premium Barolo and Barbaresco vineyards. Categorized as 'Langhe' but showing all the elegance and concentration which make the Roagna wines so iconic, this is a Rosso which shoots well beyond its expected parameters with a bright, complex palate of red cherry, orange peel, and sweet cinnamon spice. Satisfying and multi-layered with silky tannins holding the delicately sweet fruit, this is a wine to be savoured.

Moulin a Vent, Chateau du Moulin a Vent, 2015, France 99.95

Located at the heart of the prestigious Moulin-a-Vent appellation, from a vintage that was lauded as historic, comes this elegant powerful Beaujolais. Dark and glossy in the glass and bursting with juicy black cherry, dried violets and a faint spice, the wine has a surprising presence. The suave tannins feel softly integrated while the natural freshness of Gamay makes the wine dance across the palate. A hugely impressive & beautiful expression of the region !

Taurasi, Pietracupa, Campania, 2017, Italy 99.95

Sabbino Loffredo manages to harness this wild grape and craft a wine that erupts with notes of blackberry, dark cherries, wild violets, heather, dried sage, leather and earth. The palate is silky, earthy, bright yet mineral with mystical notes of stewing berries with some dark spice and a steely backbone. A super acidity carries the intense fruit flavours and the dusty like minerality lingers with the berry notes and a smoky hint. This is a seriously good wine to be opened in advance and enjoyed slowly.

Rose

Rosa Dei Frati, Ca dei Frati, Riviera del Garda, 2022, Italy 46.95

From the stunning shores of Lake Garda, A delicate salmon pink wine that is fresh but full of flavour, showing delicate red berry fruit with poise & balance.

Le Rose, Chene Bleu, Provence, 2022, France 54.95

Pale pink in colour Le Rosé displays classic Provençal red fruit aromas with notes of raspberry and redcurrant mixed with touches of pomelo grapefruit and lime. The palate is balanced and fresh, rich and elegant with a pleasant dry fruitiness and long citrus finish

Rose of Virginia, Charles Melton, Barossa Valley, 2021, Australia 59.95

Embodies the spirit and flavors of the Barossa Valley, The Rose of Virginia boasts a beautiful balance of ripe strawberries, cherries, and a delicate floral bouquet, complemented by a crisp finish that makes it so versatile with food.
