Chardonnay, Restless River, Hemel-en-Aarde, 2023, South Africa	14.95 glass
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A stunning Chardonnay from a cool-climate valley in South Africa that has become hallowed for its ability to produce expressive, elegant wines from this grape variety. Fresh ocean breezes from Walker Bay funnel through the Hemel-en-Aarde each day, cooling the vines and allowing the grapes to ripen gently over a long growing season. Sourcing grapes solely from their own estate vineyards, Craig and Anne Wessels craft wines which preserve the character of this unique region. In the glass, the Restless River is bursting with aromas of ripe blood orange, lemon peel, and struck matches. Subtle spice and a soft texture from beautifully integrated oak shows the true mastery with which the wine has been made in the cellar. A vibrant wine with a powerful, satisfying mid-palate and long finish.

Xinomavro, Domaine Chatzivaritis, Goumenissa, 2020, Greece	14.95 glass
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Chatzivaritis is an iconic boutique producer of Northern Greece. This red blend is their flagship wine, coming from the appellation of Goumenissa, famous since ancient times. Legend has it that Goumenissa wine, made of the indigenous Xinomavro and Negoska grapes, was a favourite of Philip, the King of Macedonia, father of Alexander the Great. Chatzivaritis Goumenissa reveals complex aromas of black and red cherries, subtle notes of flowers, cloves, nutmeg and vanilla. The coolness of this mountainous region, just inland from Nauossa creates a wine with generosity of fruit whilst still cultivating the structure classic of Xinomavro. It is fragrant, elegant and shows real class.

Torrontes, Amalaya, Calchaqui Valley, Salta, 2024, Argentina Argentina's white speciality is Torrontes, here with 10% Riesling added. This is silky on the palate, refreshing and bursting with citrus, blossom and peaches.	33.95
Grillo ‘Costadune’, Mandrarossa, Sicilia, 2022, Italy This is all about freshness, with its scented pear, herb and lemon filled out with subtle stone fruits. Gentle acidity flows beneath the lightly textured palate, with a long, gentle finish of green apple, pear and a hint of spice that immediately reminds us of the most authentic Sicilian atmosphere.	35.95
Vinho Verde, Wild Fermented, Vale do Homem, 2022, Portugal The ultimate expression of Loureiro is enhanced by the wild yeast ferment! Vibrant floral aromas, ripe melon and citrus, whilst the palate is bright, with ripe lemon zest acidity, beautifully textured and long on the finish.	39.95
Pinot Grigio, Franz Haas, Vigneti Delle Dolomiti, 2023, Italy Franz Haas is one of the leading producers of white wine in northern Italy. His Pinot Grigio is sourced from vineyards ranging from 350m-800m altitude in the mountainous region of Alto-Adige in northern Italy, this wine boasts a bright acidity and mineral notes with aromas of green apple, pear and citrus.	39.95
Mosaic White, Domaine Chatzivariti, Goumenissa, 2024, Greece A blend of indigenous Roditis, Xinomavro, and Assyrtiko grapes from an historic winery on mainland Greece. Clear, crystalline lemon zest and grapefruit grip the palate while blossom-like florals and a stony minerality take over on the satisfying finish. Bright and refreshing like good Greek wine should be.	47.95
Sauvignon Blanc, Tinpot Hut, Marlborough, 2023, New Zealand Aromas of passion fruit, blackcurrant, lemongrass and fresh thyme make this a truly stunning example of a Marlborough Sauvignon.	42.95
Bergerie de l’Hortus, Famille Orliac, Pic Saint Loup, 2021, France A deliciously soft white blend. 40% Roussanne, 20% Sauvignon Blanc, 20% Viognier, 10% Sauvignon Gris, 10% Chardonnay. Bergerie Blanc lights up the glass with pale, shimmering gold. The smooth, balanced palate tantalizes with complex notes of fresh herbs, white flowers, and citrus.	49.95
Picpoul De Pinet, Brechallune, La Croix Gratiot, 2023, France A premium single vineyard Picpoul with bright notes of grapefruit, lemon, and white blossom on the nose. Picked slightly later than is common for the region and aged on its lees, the palate has beautiful presence and texture.	47.95
Albarino, Pazo Senorans, Rias Baixas, 2023, Spain This is a fine mineral-driven Albarino from the leading Albarino producer in Rias Baixas. Aromas of nectarine, fresh figs, orange zest and white flowers. Dry with citrus flavours and a mineral finish. Perfect with shellfish.	55.95
Sauvignon Blanc, Sattlerhof, Sudsteiermark, 2022, Austria A classy, bone-dry expression of Austrian Sauvignon Blanc, carefully crafted from premium cool-climate vineyards in the Gamlitz region. Refreshing mineral structure on the palate is complimented with yellow plum and white peach aromatics and a juicy acidity. Refined, vibrant, and precise.	58.95

Calvarino, Soave Classico, Pieropan, 2022, Italy 59.95

Arguably the first single vineyard white to be made in Italy, this is a wine whose reputation precedes it. Clean and refreshing, the crystalline lemon and delicate elderflower merge on a pure, minerally driven palate. Mouthwatering and complex: classic Soave, done to perfection.

Carjanti Bianco, Gulfi, Sicilia, 2019, Italy 67.95

On Sicily's southeast coast, there are few people crafting wines as good as Gulfi. Working with indigenous and international grape varieties, this is a wine made from 100% organic Carricante grapes, 50% fermented in stainless steel and 50% in large used botti. Fresh and vibrant, boasting orchard fruit flavours such as peach and apple. The fruit follows through to a smooth and delicious palate.

Hereafter Here, Alheit, Hemel-en-Aarde, 2022, South Africa 69.95

Elegant, expressive Chenin Blanc from a winery that is a true master of the variety. Just inland of Hermanus Bay, Chris Alheit crafts his wines leaving no care neglected. The result is an expression which captures South Africa's classic generous fruit profile along with a purity and freshness which is seldom seen. Swelling and evolving in the glass with notes of orange blossom, ripe peaches, and chamomile tea, Hereafter Here is a joy for enthusiasts of the country and variety.

Chablis Premier Cru, Cote Lechet, Les Hauts De Milly, 2022, France 69.95

The Kimmeridgian clay soils in Côte de Léchet lend this wine a distinct saline edge and powerful character. The nose is fragrant with aromas of white flowers, lemon and apricot and hints of gunflint. On the palate are intense citrus fruit flavours and a persistent salinity which carry through to the long finish.

‘Reid Ulm’ Nussberg Wiener Gemischter Satz, Weininger, 2021, Austria 69.95

From a single vineyard overlooking Vienna, a traditional field blend of nine grape varieties, ‘Reid Ulm’ is absolutely unique and a joy to drink. With shoots of gold in the glass, it has elegant aromatics of ripe white and yellow fruit - balancing a full bodied softness with a limestone mineral precision that refreshes each sip. Lush and concentrated with a lingering salinity.

Bourgogne Blanc, Clos du Chateau, Domaine de Montille, 2021, France 99.95

Sourced entirely from a single, organically farmed vineyard located within the walls of the actual Chateau Puligny-Montrachet itself which was classed as the garden when the original classification for the region took place, this vineyard is now home to 50 year old vines which exemplify the elegance attainable from truly well crafted Burgundy Chardonnay. Delicate white blossom and peaches on the nose give way to a strongly textured palate with a flinty, mineral edge.

Chardonnay, Whitewolfe, North Downs, 2022, England 89.95

The maiden release from Clare Whitehead and Luke Wolfe at Kit's Coty in the North Downs of England has received huge critical acclaim. This shows clearly that the days of English terroir only producing sparkling wines are long gone. Vibrant and fresh with a classic mineral edge, intrinsic to good English wine, the wine evolves in the glass revealing masterfully integrated oak which lends the palate weight and presence.

Roussanne, Chateau Le Devay, Northern Rhone, 2022, France 89.95

Le Devay shows the generosity and tension possible from the great terroirs of the Northern Rhone Valley. Carefully harvested by hand and fermented slowly at low temperatures to preserve the aromatics of the grape, this is beautifully textured and brimming with vibrant citrus notes of lemon peel and grapefruit.

Merlot, Montes, Colchagua Valley, 2022, Chile Vibrant ruby red in colour, this plummy Merlot has hints of vanilla and chocolate with velvety tannins, crisp acidity and a fragrant finish.	31.95
Mencia, Merayo, DO Bierzo, 2023, Spain Made from over 80 year old Mencia bush vines. There is no oak treatment to preserve the aromatic fresh red fruit quality of this variety. Fresh and herbal with a hint of spice on the finish.	32.95
The Blend, Gabrielskloof, Walker Bay, 2021, South Africa 49% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Cabernet Franc, 14% Petit Verdot, 7% Malbec This blend has aromas of delicate violets and black fruit, with hints of vanilla and tobacco leaf from the time in barrel. Fine velvety tannins and restrained power, balanced with bright acidity and a juicy palate.	41.95
Cotes du Rhone Villages, Guillaume Gonnet, 2023, France A blend of Grenache (80%) and Syrah (20%), this Côtes-du-Rhône Villages is rich and complex. Generous red and black berry fruit are underpinned with subtle pepper spice and savoury herbs on the full bodied palate.	42.95
‘Vinista’ Pais, Pedro Parra, Itata Valley, 2021, Chile A unique wine from one the oldest winemaking regions of Chile. Sourced from 120 year old vines, this Pais gives concentrated notes of cranberry, juniper, wild herbs, and white pepper. Light and delicate.	46.95
Shiraz, The Cunning Plan, Thistledown, McLaren Vale, 2022, Australia Fruit comes from the Moray Park vineyard in the McLaren Flat sub-region. Low yielding and ultra-intense, Great depth of ripe plum and blackberry fruit flavours. A full bodied wine with a succulent palate, lively spices and fine velvety tannins.	48.95
Malbec Blend, Disobedience, Kaiken, Mendoza, 2021, Argentina ‘Disobedience’ by Francis Mallmann represents the long collaboration between the Argentinian chef and Kaiken. Known for his distinct style of open fire cooking this is a blend of Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot sourced from Altamira and Vistalba. A rounded, rich wine with expressive sweet and spiced red fruit.	49.95
Zeta, Pegaso, Sierra De Gredos, 2021, Spain The personal project of legendary Rioja winemaker Telmo Rodríguez, Zeta is 100% Garnacha. Classically Spanish, the wine is bursting with red fruit notes, soft spices and a rustic wild herb finish. Aged partially in French oak for added complexity, this is full of personality and character.	54.95
Barbera D’Alba, G.D.Vajra, Piedmonte, 2024, Italy Scented, balanced and lively, Vajra’s Barbera d’Alba combines wild forest fruit aromatics with ripe, thirst-quenching raspberry and blackberry with a hint of fig. A wine made with great character and intensity.	55.95
Rioja Reserva, Bodegas Luis Canas 2018, Spain A delicious Reserva from one of the top Rioja Bodegas. It has a dark berry fruit nose and an elegant, flavourful blackberry and raspberry palate together with complex layers of oak, cocoa and balsam hints. Structure, elegance and length.	58.95

Pinot Noir, Iona, Elgin Highlands, 2023, South Africa 58.95

A classic, aromatic Pinot Noir from some of the coolest vineyards in South Africa. Delicate rose petal florals, wild strawberry and raspberry lead the palate, underpinned with soft earthy notes. Freshly perfumed with beautiful structure.

Tempranillo ‘Aciano’, Alvar De Dios, Castilla y Leon, 2020, Spain 64.95

Along the banks of the Duero River nestled close to the Portuguese border, Toro is home to some of the oldest vineyards in the world and has remained largely untouched by modernity. Aciano is a classic expression of the region, made entirely from the local cultivar of Tempranillo (Tinta de Toro) and bursting with succulent wild blackberries and dark cherry notes. Intertwined with delicate floral aromas, the wine feels distinctly Spanish in style with an engaging rusticity and presence in the glass.

Ribera del Duero, Finca Villacreces, 2020, Spain 69.95

Made from a meticulous selection of the best vines from the estate’s 15 vineyard plots. A perfect blend of 86% Tempranillo, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon and 4% Merlot. Inky purple, with an expressive bouquet of mocha/espresso, toasted bread, graphite, wild blueberries and blackberry liqueur. Full-bodied and plush on the palate, with layers of spicy black fruits and a smoky finish.

Duo, Mecori, Etna Rosso DOC, 2021, Italy 96.95

This classic blend of Nerello Mascalese and Cappuccio is a passion project of two young Italian winemakers. Made from a tiny terraced vineyard located high on the North face of Mount Etna, the wine sings of its unique volcanic terroir. Tended entirely by hand and carefully managed in the winery to preserve the natural purity of these indigenous varieties, the wine is elegant and vibrant with a beautiful floral delicacy. Refreshing bright red berry fruit and mineral notes guide the palate to a long, refined finish. Really stunning.

Moulin a Vent, Chateau du Moulin a Vent, 2015, France 99.95

Located at the heart of the prestigious Moulin-a-Vent appellation, from a vintage that was lauded as historic, comes this elegant Beaujolais. Dark and glossy in the glass and bursting with juicy cherry, dried violets and a faint spice, the wine has a surprising presence. The suave tannins feel softly integrated while the natural freshness of Gamay makes the wine dance across the palate. A beautiful expression of the region.

Amarone della Valpolicella, Torre di Terzolan , 2017, Italy 149.95

Sumptuous and powerful, this is classic Amarone done exceptionally well. The nose is complex and ethereal, swelling with new layers of nuance as the wine opens in the glass. Elegant on the palate with wonderful structure from characteristically sweet tannins, there are aromatic notes of dark cherries, blueberries and chocolate combined with hints of sweet spice. Incredibly deep and satisfying, this is everything that should be experienced from one of the key wine styles of Italy.

Rose

Rosa Dei Frati, Ca dei Frati, Riviera del Garda, 2023, Italy 49.95

From the stunning shores of Lake Garda, a delicate salmon pink wine that is fresh but full of flavour, showing delicate red berry fruit with poise & balance.

Le Rose, Chene Bleu, Provence, 2022, France 59.95

Delicate pink in colour Le Rosé displays classic Provençal red fruit aromas with notes of raspberry and redcurrant mixed with touches of pomelo grapefruit and lime. The palate is balanced and elegantly fresh with a long citrus finish.
